BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS Meeting of January 2, 2020

Commissioner Susan Thompson called the regularly scheduled meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. on January 2, 2020. Those present were, Commissioner Susan Thompson, Commissioner Kristie Borchers, Commissioner Sara Gutterman, Administrator Jami Scroggins, Attorney Michael O'Loughlin, Accounting Administrator Lynn McNitt, Road & Bridge Supervisor JoAllen Blowers, EMS Director Buffy Witt, Public Health Director Tara Hardy, Clerk Joan Roberts and general public.

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Commissioner Borchers modified the agenda with the postponement of the Charge Ahead Colorado Grant Application Letter of Support to the January 15, 2020 commissioner's meeting.

Commissioner Borchers motioned to approve the agenda. Commissioner Gutterman seconded. Motion carried.

Commissioner Borchers motioned to approve the December 2019 Minutes. Commissioner Gutterman seconded. Motion carried.

There were no citizen comments from the floor.

Commissioner Gutterman motioned to approve the Emergency Manager Employment Agreement with Phil Graham. Commissioner Borchers seconded. This agreement is for \$43,000.00 per year, fulltime/exempt employment and the supervisor will be the County Administrator. Commissioner Thompson expressed her reservations about this decision, but will support the majority decision. The commissioners stated that they honor and respect each other's viewpoints. Commissioners Borchers and Gutterman voted aye and Commissioner Thompson voted nay. Motion carried.

Commissioner Borchers motioned to approve the Emergency Manager Appointment of Phil Graham. Commissioner Gutterman seconded. This appointment is pursuant to C.R.S. 24-33.5-707(4): The minimum composition of an emergency management agency is a director or coordinator appointed and governed by the chief executive officer or governing body of the appointing jurisdiction. The commissioners thanked Administrator Scroggins for serving as the Interim Emergency Manager Director since April 2019. Commissioners Borchers and Gutterman voted aye and Commissioner Thompson voted nay. Motion carried.

Commissioner Borchers motioned to approve the USGS Upper Gunnison Water Monitoring Agreement. Commissioner Gutterman seconded. The cost for the USGS to continue the water-quality sampling program for the period of January 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020 is \$3,296.00. Of this amount, \$2,360.00 will be provided by the County and \$936.00 will be provided by USFS matching funds. Motion carried.

Commissioner Borchers motioned to approve the Marketing Agreement for APH Creative Design for Social Media/PR. Commissioner Gutterman seconded. This agreement is not to exceed \$24,000.00, for the fiscal year 2020 and is by and between Hinsdale County, Hinsdale County Marketing Committee and the Lake City-Hinsdale County Chamber of Commerce and Angela P. Hollingsworth (DBA: APH Creative Design LLC). Commissioner Borchers requested the removal of the Chamber of Commerce from the agreement and to add the address for APH. Motion carried.

Commissioner Borchers motioned to approve the BLM's request to use the county logo on the Alpine Loop entrance portal signs. Commissioner Gutterman seconded. Motion carried.

Commissioner Borchers motioned to approve establishing a pullout on County Road 20 for USDA/NRCS interpretive sign near Hidden Treasure Dam. Commissioner Gutterman seconded. NRCS would be responsible for funding and producing the sign and approval will be needed from Mr. George Hurd. Motion carried.

There was no unscheduled business to come before the board.

Commissioner Borchers motioned to pay all approved bills. Commissioner Gutterman seconded. Motion carried.

Official reports were given.

The meeting adjourned at 10:46 a.m.

Commissioner Susan Thompson called the regularly scheduled meeting to order at 9:26 a.m. on January 15, 2020. Those present were, Commissioner Susan Thompson, Commissioner Kristie Borchers, Commissioner Sara Gutterman was absent, Administrator Jami Scroggins, Treasurer Lori Lawrence, Assessor Luke de la Parra, Undersheriff Chris Kambish, Deputy Sheriff Jordan Kaminski, Deputy sheriff Tom Carl, Clerk Joan Roberts and general public.

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The order of the agenda was changed, but there were no modifications to the agenda.

Commissioner Borchers motioned to approve the agenda. Commissioner Thompson seconded. Motion carried.

Under citizen comments from the floor, Henry Woods asked the commissioners about helping with the ice rink on the lake. He stated that the machine he used to clear the ice has broken down and needs repair. The commissioners stated that they had checked in to the possibility of helping, but were told that they cannot take on that type of liability. Mr. Woods also told the commissioners that purchasing the peninsula on Lake San

Cristobal would enhance the value with the public use of the lake. Mr. Woods' last comment was about his support of reintroducing wolves to the state.

Also under citizen comments from the floor, Rick Hernandez commended the new EMS Director Buffy Witt and stated that she has great ideas and good energy. In the short time she has been here good things are up and running with trainings scheduled, personnel and agency resources.

Commissioner Borchers motioned to approve the IGA for the provision of snowplowing services by Hinsdale County to the Town of Lake City. Commissioner Thompson seconded. There were some modifications, which include marking any and all known hazards. Motion carried.

Commissioner Borchers motioned to approve the Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) 2020 application. Commissioner Thompson seconded. The contact phone number will be updated. Motion carried.

Commissioner Borchers motioned to adopt Resolution No. 1, Series 2020, a resolution setting county mileage reimbursement rate. Commissioner Thompson seconded. The county uses 80% of the IRS mileage reimbursement rate. This sets the 2020 rate at 46 cents per mile. Motion carried.

Commissioner Borchers motioned to adopt Resolution No. 2, Series 2020, a resolution adopting the Hinsdale County Emergency Operations Plan (EOP). Commissioner Thompson seconded. This plan is a statutory requirement and will be a fluid document with modifications made as needed. Motion carried.

Commissioner Borchers motioned to approve the Main Street Mini-Grant Application for 2020. Commissioner Thompson seconded. This grant will be for the Courthouse landscaping in the amount of \$9,500.00 and the installation of a Fast Charger in the amount of \$500.00. The county has budgeted \$4,000.00 to be applied to the total cost of \$43,375.00 for these projects. Motion carried.

Commissioner Borchers motioned to approve the Website Design and Management Agreement between Hinsdale County, the Hinsdale County Marketing Committee, the Lake City-Hinsdale County Chamber of Commerce and VistaWorks. Commissioner Thompson seconded. This is a revised contract for the redesign and redevelopment of the website lakecity.com for a fee of \$12,500.00. The Marketing Committee and the Chamber of Commerce will each be responsible for \$1,250.00 and the remaining \$10,000.00 shall be paid through grants. Motion carried.

Commissioner Borchers motioned to approve the Hinsdale County Board of County Commissioners Department & Commission Goals and Strategic Actions for 2020. Commissioner Thompson seconded. The commissioners thanked the department heads and Administrator Scoggins for the updated goals and they will prioritize and move forward with them. Motion carried.

There was no unscheduled business to come before the board.

Commissioner Borchers motioned to pay all approved bills. Commissioner Thompson seconded. Motion carried.

At this time the commissioners paused the meeting for the swearing-in of Sheriff Christopher Kambish.

Commissioner Thompson opened the Public Hearing at 10:06 a.m. for the Special Events Permit requested by the Lake City/Chamber of Commerce for the Annual Brew-Ski event on Lake San Cristobal. There were no comments received.

Commissioner Thompson closed the Public Hearing and resumed the regular meeting.

Commissioner Borchers motioned to approve the Special Events Permit from the Lake City/Hinsdale County Chamber of Commerce. Commissioner Thompson seconded. This is for the Annual Brew-Ski event on Lake San Cristobal to be held on February 15, 2020 from 8:00 a.m. through 5:00 p.m. Motion carried.

The meeting adjourned at 10:08 a.m.
