Due to the COVID-19 Local Disaster Emergency declaration on March 14, 2020 the commissioners meeting was held virtually and by telephone. Those present were, Commissioner Susan Thompson, Commissioner Kristie Borchers, Commissioner Sara Gutterman and Attorney Mike O'Loughlin (from 3:38-3:54 p.m.).

Commissioner Gutterman motioned to go into Executive Session for the discussion of a personnel matter under C.R.S. Section 24-6-402(4)(f) to discuss the position of County Administrator and not involving: any specific employees who have requested discussion of a matter in open session; any member of this body or any elected official; the appointment of any person to fill an office of the body or of an elected official; or personnel policies that do not require discussion of matters personal to particular employees. Commissioner Borchers seconded. Motion carried.

Commissioner Thompson modified the agenda with the deletions of the Boundary Adjustment for the Ute-Ulay Covenant with State of Colorado and the Building Code ad-hoc committee appointment.

Commissioner Borchers motioned to approve the agenda. Commissioner Gutterman seconded. Motion carried.

Commissioner Borchers motioned to approve the May 2020 minutes. Commissioner Gutterman seconded. Motion carried.

There were no citizen comments from the floor (phone).

Commissioner Borchers motioned to approve a Second Variance Request from some of the Governor's Safer at Home Executive Order. Commissioner Gutterman seconded. The key points in this request include: changes to guidelines for theaters; changing the gathering size from 10 to 50 people that still

includes social distancing; and still includes by reference the variances from the first request about churches and restaurants. Motion carried.

Commissioner Borchers motioned to adopt Resolution No. 7, Series 2020, a resolution implementing Stage One Fire Restrictions in the Piedra Region of unincorporated Southern Hinsdale County.

Commissioner Gutterman seconded. This restriction goes into effect on June 4, 2020 at 8:00 a.m. and is the same as the restrictions already in place in Archuleta County. Motion carried.

Commissioner Gutterman motioned to adopt Resolution No. 8, Series 2020, a resolution allocating monies received pursuant to Colorado Revised Statutes 30-29-101, and the Secure Rural Schools and Community Self Determination Act of 2000, as reauthorized, relating to receipts from National Forests and PILT disbursement. Commissioner Borchers seconded. As per the committee's determination, the money will be split 50% for Road & Bridge and 50% for the Hinsdale and Archuleta School Districts. Motion carried.

Commissioner Gutterman motioned to approve the Title 1 Secure and Rural Schools letter of agreement with Hinsdale County School Board. Commissioner Borchers seconded. The committee of 3 school board members and 3 county members made an agreement to split the Title 1 monies 50% for each entity for the funding received in the years 2020 and 2021. Motion carried.

Commissioner Borchers motioned to approve the Hinsdale County Ambulance Service Licenses.

Commissioner Gutterman seconded. The license is renewed annually and includes all 3 ambulances.

Thank you to Buffy Witt, Sandy Hines and JoAllen Blowers for their work in getting the ambulances to meet all the requirements of the licenses. Motion carried.

Commissioner Borchers motioned to approve the Addendum to the Amended IGA with the Lake San Cristobal Water Activity Enterprise. Commissioner Gutterman seconded. Motion carried.

There was no unscheduled business to come before the board.

Commissioner Gutterman motioned to pay all approved bills. Commissioner Thompson seconded. Motion carried.

Official reports were given.

Commissioner Gutterman motioned to go into Executive Session for the discussion of a personnel matter under C.R.S.
