BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS Meeting January 6, 2021

Commissioner Kristie Borchers called the regularly scheduled meeting to order at 10:32 a.m. on January 6, 2021. Those present were, Commissioner Kristie Borchers, Commissioner Susan Thompson, Commissioner Sara Gutterman, Attorney Mike O'Loughlin, Administrator Sandy Hines, Finance Director Lynn McNitt, Road and Bridge Supervisor Don Menzies, Building Official Richard Kimball, Assessor Luke de la Parra, Public Health Director Tara Hardy, Sheriff Chris Kambish, EMS Director Buffy Witt, Emergency Manager Phil Graham, Coroner Jerry Gray, Clerk Joan Roberts and general public.

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Commissioner Borchers modified the agenda with the deletion of consideration of San Juan National Forest Mag Chloride Agreement for 2021. More clarification is needed before approval can be given.

Commissioner Thompson motioned to approve the agenda. Commissioner Gutterman seconded. Motion carried.

Commissioner Gutterman motioned to approve the December 2020 minutes. Commissioner Thompson seconded. Motion carried.

There were no citizen comments from the floor.

Commissioner Thompson motioned to approve the 2021 Emergency Management Program Grant Application. Commissioner Gutterman seconded. This is an annual contract with the State of Colorado Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Management in the amount of \$34,094.00. Motion carried.

Commissioner Thompson motioned to adopt Resolution No. 1, Series 2021, a resolution declaring participation in Colorado Department of Transportation's Off-Highway Vehicle (OHV) Pilot Program. Commissioner Borchers seconded. This resolution proposes to extend the pilot program pending the approval of CDOT for 3 years, including 2021, 2022 and 2023, beginning on the Friday before Memorial Day through September 30th each year, and includes the route on State Highway 149 from Oceanwave Drive (mile marker 73) to County Road 30 (mile marker 71.4). Commissioner Gutterman stated that she represents the citizen with concerns about not having enough data on the long term effects of the program. Commissioners Thompson and Borchers voted aye. Commissioner Gutterman voted nay. Motion carried.

Commissioner Thompson motioned to approve the 2021 United States Geological Survey (USGS) Water Quality Sampling Agreement. Commissioner Gutterman seconded. This is an annual agreement in the amount of \$3,395.00, of which the County will provide \$2,431.00 and the USGS will provide \$964.00. Motion carried.

Commissioner Thompson motioned to approve the Whistleblower Addendum to the Personnel Policy.
Commissioner Gutterman seconded. The addition of section 2.13 was added to include a
Whistleblowers Policy. This is a requirement of the Department of Homeland Security and Emergency
Management. The new policy will be dated January 6, 2021. Motion carried.

Commissioner Thompson motioned to adopt Resolution No. 2, Series 2021, a resolution amending the Hinsdale County Boat Dock Policy. Commissioner Gutterman seconded. This amendment addresses the commercial use of the boat dock, which will include 4 boat slips at a cost of \$1,200.00 each per season. Motion carried.

There was no unscheduled business to come before the board.

Commissioner Thompson motioned to pay all approved bills. Commissioner Gutterman seconded. Motion carried.

Official reports were given.

The meeting adjourned at 11:22 a.m.

Commissioner Kristie Borchers called the special meeting to order at 10:18 a.m. on January 12, 2021. Those present were, Commissioner Kristie Borchers, Commissioner Robert Hurd, Commissioner Greg Levine, Administrator Sandy Hines, Clerk Joan Roberts and general public.

Commissioner Levine motioned to approve the letter of support for the National Collaborative of Women's History for the installation of a Suffrage Centennial Marker at the Hinsdale County Courthouse. Commissioner Hurd seconded. History Colorado is applying for a grant from The William G Pomeroy Foundation which includes the Hinsdale County Courthouse as one of the sites. Motion carried.

The meeting adjourned at 10:19 a.m.

Commissioner Kristie Borchers called the regularly scheduled meeting to order at 10:08 a.m. on January 20, 2021. Those present were, Commissioner Kristie Borchers, Commissioner Robert Hurd, Commissioner Greg Levine, Attorney Mike O'Loughlin, Administrator Sandy Hines, Finance Director Lynn McNitt, Treasurer Lori Lawrence, Road and Bridge Supervisor Don Menzies, Building Official Richard Kimball, Assessor Luke de la Parra, Under Sheriff Jordan Kaminski, EMS Director Buffy Witt, Clerk Joan Roberts and general public.

Commissioner Borchers opened the Public Hearing to hear any comments about the Resolution to Amend the Hinsdale County Zoning Regulations to allow Communications Towers as a Special Use in RAD 2 Zoning District.

No comments were received. The Public Hearing adjourned at 10:10 a.m.

Commissioner Borchers opened 4 Project Plan Design Qualification Applications received for the Lake San Cristobal Project. The first application was received from Design Workshop on January 18, 2021 for a proposed 300-450 hours at a cost of \$40,870.00 to \$53,870.00. The second application was received from Tres Birds on January 19, 2021 for a proposed cost of: \$210.00 per hour for the Design Principal; \$140.00 per hour for Architect; \$70.00 per hour for Project Manager; and \$50.00 per hour for Drafting. There was no total cost given for the project. The third application was received from Design Concepts on January 19, 2021 for a proposed 427 hours at a cost of \$53,412.00. The fourth application was received from DHM Design on January 19, 2021 for a proposed cost of \$54,790.00, with optional services in the amount of \$8,250.00.

Commissioner Borchers recessed the meeting at 10:19 a.m. go back in to the workshop.

The meeting reconvened at 10:40 a.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

There were no modifications to the agenda.

Commissioner Levine motioned to approve the agenda. Commissioner Hurd seconded. Motion carried

Under citizen comments from the floor the commissioners expressed their sympathy to the family of Ed Campbell.

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Commissioner Hurd motioned to adopt Resolution No. 3, Series 2021, an amended resolution by and between Hinsdale County and Mineral County of the State of Colorado establishing a District Public Health Agency. Commissioner Levine seconded. Changes made in Section 6 and 19 were not included in Resolution 22, Series 2020 that was adopted December 16, 2020, which is now null and void with this amended resolution. Motion carried.

Commissioner Hurd motioned to adopt Resolution No. 4, Series 2021, a resolution amending Hinsdale County Zoning & Development Regulations to add Subsection 2.7-2j thereto to allow for Communications Towers as a Special Use by Permit only in the RAD 2 Zoning District. Commissioner Levine seconded. The Public Hearing this morning was to address any comments about this change. No comments were received. The Planning Commission has reviewed this change and have given their approval. Motion carried.

Commissioner Levine motioned to approve the Special Events Permit for the Chamber of Commerce for the Annual Brew-Ski Event. Commissioner Hurd seconded. This event will be held on February 6, 2021 at Lake San Cristobal. No comments were received by the deadline of January 15, 2021 by 5:00 p.m., so a Public Hearing was not required. Motion carried.

Commissioner Levine motioned to adopt Resolution No. 5, Series 2021, a resolution changing the signers on the Bank of the West warrant account. Commissioner Hurd seconded. The bank required a resolution to change the signers on the bank account. Motion carried.

Commissioner Levine motioned to approve the acknowledgement of a Code of Ethics Signature Page within the Personnel Policy. Commissioner Hurd seconded. This is a Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Management requirement. The new commissioners need to sign that they received the Personnel Policy. Motion carried.

Commissioner Hurd motioned to approve the 2021 Western Regional Emergency Medical & Trauma Advisory Council (WRETAC) Funding Agreement. Commissioner Levine seconded. This is an annual grant and the first quarterly request is in the amount of \$10,592.00. No match is required. Motion carried.

Commissioner Levine motioned to approve the Road Project Agreement. Commissioner Hurd seconded. This agreement is between Hinsdale County and the USDA, Forest Service, San Juan National Forest for the application of magnesium chloride on the Upper Piedra Road. The agreement is not to exceed \$20,000.00, which will be paid by the Forest Service. Motion carried.

Commissioner Levine motioned to adopt Resolution No. 6, Series 2021, a resolution adopting an amended Grants Management Policy. Commissioner Hurd seconded. After submitting the policy to the Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, there were a few changes needed. This resolution amends the one approved on December 29, 2020. Motion carried.

There was no unscheduled business to come before the board.

Commissioner Hurd motioned to pay all approved bills. Commissioner Levine seconded. Motion carried.

The meeting adjourned at 11:01 a.m.
