RESOLUTION NO. 14 SERIES 2019

A RESOLUTION TERMINATING THE LOCAL EMERGENCY POST-AVALANCHE EVENTS WHICH RESULTED IN MASSIVE AMOUNTS OF DEBRIS IN WATERWAYS

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. §§ 24-33.5-703 and 709(1), Hinsdale County Administrator and Interim Emergency Manager, Jami Scroggins, acting as Principal Executive Officer, declared a local disaster emergency at 3 p.m. on May 2, 2019 due to post-avalanche events, including but not limited to, massive amounts of debris clogging the local waterways; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Hinsdale County, Colorado confirmed and continued the local avalanche disaster emergency declaration via written Resolution No. 11, Series 2019, on May 4, 2019; and

WHEREAS, upon information and belief, the debris conditions and events that led to the disaster emergency declaration have been mitigated to a point that there is no longer an imminent threat to persons or property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Hinsdale County, Colorado on this 10th day of July, 2019, that:

- 1. The local debris in waterways emergency declaration referenced above is hereby terminated; and
- 2. Pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-33.5-709(1), this Resolution terminating the local debris emergency declaration shall be given prompt and general publicity and filed promptly with the Hinsdale County Clerk and Recorder and the State of Colorado's Office of Emergency
