## A RESOLUTION OF HINSDALE COUNTY SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION FOR A CONSTRUCTION GRANT FROM THE COLORADO PARKS AND WILDLIFE STATE RECREATIONAL TRAILS GRANT PROGRAM, 2022 NON-MOTORIZED TRAILS GRANT, FOR THE PENINSULA PARK TRAIL PROJECT

WHEREAS potential funding is available through a grant program administered by Colorado Parks and Wildlife, and

WHEREAS Hinsdale County will be constructing trails proposed in Peninsula Park purchased in December of 2020 by Hinsdale County with help from the Trust For Public Land, Great Outdoors Colorado (GOCO) and private funders,

WHEREAS the trails plan is part of the Peninsula Park master plan and trails work will start in 2022, and

WHEREAS Hinsdale County supporting the required 30 percent cost share per the identified budget, and

WHEREAS the grant funding will be used for the construction of the trails plan of the Peninsula Park to provide important trail and recreation opportunities for residents and visitors, and

WHEREAS the Peninsula Park is owned and operated by Hinsdale County, is adjacent to the Hinsdale County Boat Launch Facility, and situated along Lake San Cristobal, and is protected by a perpetual Conservation Easement held by Colorado Open Lands, and

WHEREAS it is in the best interest of Hinsdale County to submit this grant application for the Peninsula Park trail system as other funding sources are pending or yet to be requested.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Hinsdale County, Colorado on this 29th day of September, 2021, that:

- 1. Hinsdale County Board of County Commissioners hereby approve the submission of a grant application to the Colorado Parks and Wildlife State Recreational Trails Grant program 2022 non-motorized trails grant.
- 2. If awarded, Hinsdale County will complete the Peninsula Park trails system construction and provide long-term maintenance of the Peninsula Park trails system.
- 3. If the grant is awarded, Hinsdale County will hereby authorize Chair Commissioner Kristie Borchers to sign the grant agreement with the Colorado Parks and Wildlife.
