**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING REALIGNED COUNTY COMMISSIONER  
DISTRICTS IN HINSDALE COUNTY, COLORADO**

**WHEREAS**, Colorado Revised Statutes § 30-10-306(4) requires that County Commissioners reestablish each Commissioner District as nearly equal in population as possible with no more than a five percent difference in each commissioner district based on the most current federal census and pursuant to Colorado Revised Statutes § 2-2-902; and

**WHEREAS**, the reestablishment of close to equally populated Commissioner Districts is desirable for the fair representation of the registered voters in each District; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners is hereby realigning the boundaries of each County Commissioner District to ensure equitable representation in accordance with Colorado law; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Colorado Revised Statutes § 30-10-306(5), a public hearing was held on the proposed new Commissioner District boundaries on August 2, 2023, which hearing occurred at least 30 days before the adoption of this Resolution.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, THAT:**

1. The following new Commissioner Districts are established:

**Commissioner District One (1) – All the area that is west and north of a line formed by:** Starting at the northern Hinsdale County boundary at the west side of Colorado State Highway (“SH”) 149, then south on SH 149 to Elm Drive., turning right onto Elm Dr, then westerly on Elm Dr. to Balsam Drive, turning right onto Balsam Dr., then northwesterly on Balsam Dr. to Black Bear Hill, turning left onto Black Bear Hill, then southerly on Black Bear Hill to Ocean Wave Drive., continuing southerly on Ocean Wave Dr. to the Town of Lake City boundary limit, turning right along the town boundary and continuing southerly along the town boundary to 10 ½ Street, continuing southerly on 10 ½ St. to Ocean Wave Dr., turning right onto Ocean Wave Dr. and continuing southerly along the property boundary between 956 Ocean Wave Dr. and 951 SH 149 to SH 149. Turning right onto SH 149, continue southerly to the southern Town of Lake City boundary, turn right to follow the Town boundary limit and following the Town boundary limit west and north to County Road 20, then left onto County Road 20 and west on County Road 20 to the western County boundary at Engineer Pass.

**Commissioner District Two (2) - All the area that is east and south of a line formed by:**

Starting at northern Hinsdale County boundary on SH 149 and going south on SH 149 to San Juan Drive, turning left onto San Juan Dr. and then easterly on San Juan Dr. to the Lake Fork of the Gunnison River, then turn right onto Lake Fork Gunnison River course, then south along said river to the Town of Lake City boundary limit, turning left onto the Town boundary limit, then following the Town boundary limit southwesterly to 6<sup>th</sup> Street, turning right onto 6<sup>th</sup> St., continue westerly to Water Street, turning right on Water St. and continuing northerly to 7<sup>th</sup> Street, turning left onto 7<sup>th</sup> St. and continuing westerly to the Lake Fork of the Gunnison River. Turn left onto the river course and continue southerly to Park Creek Road, turning right onto Park Creek Rd., continue southwesterly to SH 149. Turn right on SH 149 and continue northerly to Vine Street, turning left onto Vine St. and continue westerly to Alpine Street, turning right onto Alpine St., continue northerly to vacated Spruce Street, turning right onto Spruce St. continue easterly to Park Street, turning left onto Park St., continue northerly to Cleborn Street, turning right on Cleborn St., continue easterly to SH 149. Turn left onto SH 149 and continue northerly to the Town of Lake City boundary, turn left to follow the Town boundary limit, and continue westerly and north onto County Road 20, then along County Road 20 to the western County boundary at Engineer Pass.

**Commissioner District Three (3) - All the area that is within a line formed by:**

Starting at the intersection of SH 149 and San Juan Drive, then continue easterly on San Juan Drive to the Lake Fork of the Gunnison River, then turn right at the Lake Fork of the Gunnison River and continue south along the river course to the Town of Lake City boundary limit, turn left onto Town boundary limit line, then follow the Town boundary limit westerly then southerly to 6<sup>th</sup> Street, turning right on 6<sup>th</sup> St. continue westerly to Water Street, turning right onto Water St. and continuing northerly to 7<sup>th</sup> Street, turning left onto 7<sup>th</sup> St. and continuing westerly to Lake Fork of the Gunnison River course. Turn left on the lake course, then continue southerly on the lake course to Park Creek Road, turning right onto Park Creek Rd., continue southwesterly to SH 149. Turn right on SH 149 and continue northerly to Vine Street, turning left onto Vine St. and continue westerly to Alpine Street, turning right onto Alpine Street, continue northerly to vacated Spruce Street, turning right onto Spruce St. continue easterly to Park Street, turning left onto Park St. continue northerly to Cleborn Street, turning right on Cleborn St., continue easterly to SH 149. Turn left onto SH 149 and continue northerly to property boundary between 956 Ocean Wave Dr. and 951 SH 149, turning left onto the property boundary between 956 Ocean Wave Dr. and 951 SH 149, continue westerly to Ocean Wave Dr., turning right onto Ocean Wave Dr. continue westerly to 10 ½ Street, turning left onto 10 ½ St., continue westerly to the Town of Lake City boundary limit, continue west and north to Ocean Wave Dr, turning left onto Ocean Wave Dr., continue northerly onto Black Bear Hill, turning right onto Black Bear Hill, continue north to Balsam Dr., turning right onto Balsam Dr., turning right onto Balsam Dr. and continuing east and south to Elm Drive., turning left onto Elm Dr. and continuing easterly to SH 149, then left onto SH 149 and north to the intersection of SH 149 and San Juan Dr., to the Point of Beginning.

2. Any and all previous resolutions designating Commissioner Districts are hereby rescinded and replaced by this Resolution.
3. A map showing these realigned county commissioner districts according to the above

descriptions is attached hereto as Exhibit A and is incorporated herein by this reference. Said map is available in the County Clerk and Recorder's office for all citizens to review and be informed on the new commissioner districts.
