## A RESOLUTION TERMINATING THE COVID-19 LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY DECLARATION

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. §§ 24-33.5-703 and 709(1), Hinsdale County Administrator, Sandy Hines, acting as Hinsdale County's Principal Executive Officer, declared a local disaster emergency at 8:15 a.m. on March 14, 2020, due to the presence of the COVID-19 virus in Hinsdale County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Hinsdale County, Colorado confirmed and continued the COVID-19 local disaster emergency declaration via written Resolution No. 5, Series 2020, on March 18, 2020; and

WHEREAS, due to the widespread availability and usage of the COVID-19 vaccine, and upon other information and belief, the conditions and events that led to the COVID-19 disaster emergency declaration have been mitigated to a point that there is no longer an imminent threat to persons or property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Hinsdale County, Colorado on this 14h day of July 2021, that:

- 1. The COVID-19 local disaster emergency declaration referenced above is hereby terminated; and
- 2. Pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-33.5-709(1), this Resolution terminating the COVID-19 local disaster emergency declaration shall be given prompt and general publicity and filed promptly with the Hinsdale County Clerk and Recorder and the State of Colorado's Office of Emergency Management.
