**A RESOLUTION TERMINATING THE COVID-19  
LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY DECLARATION**

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. §§ 24-33.5-703 and 709(1), Hinsdale County Administrator, Sandy Hines, acting as Hinsdale County's Principal Executive Officer, declared a local disaster emergency at 8:15 a.m. on March 14, 2020, due to the presence of the COVID-19 virus in Hinsdale County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Hinsdale County, Colorado confirmed and continued the COVID-19 local disaster emergency declaration via written Resolution No. 5, Series 2020, on March 18, 2020; and

WHEREAS, due to the widespread availability and usage of the COVID-19 vaccine, and upon other information and belief, the conditions and events that led to the COVID-19 disaster emergency declaration have been mitigated to a point that there is no longer an imminent threat to persons or property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Hinsdale County, Colorado on this 7<sup>th</sup> day of July 2021, that:

1. The COVID-19 local disaster emergency declaration referenced above is hereby terminated; and
2. Pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-33.5-709(1), this Resolution terminating the COVID-19 local disaster emergency declaration shall be given prompt and general publicity and filed promptly with the Hinsdale County Clerk and Recorder and the State of Colorado's Office of Emergency Management.
