A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL AFFAIRS FOR A HINSDALE COUNTY ASSET INVENTORY AND ASSESSMENT

WHEREAS, Hinsdale County is dedicated to providing core services that help improve the Quality of Place, Economic Health, and Lifestyle of the community;

WHEREAS, one of the essential core services that Hinsdale County provides is to continually update and work on Capitol Improvement Planning; and

WHEREAS, Hinsdale County has identified the ability to allocate \$10,000 for an Asset Inventory and Assessment with a \$10,000 grant request from the Department of Local Affairs;

WHEREAS, Hinsdale County anticipates that completion of the Asset Inventory and Assessment will be completed in no more than 18 months and help guide the County's Capitol Improvement Planning project;

WHEREAS, Hinsdale County is not able to fund this high-priority project in full without the assistance from the Department of Local Affairs; and

WHEREAS, Hinsdale County is interested in seeking grant funds from the Department of Local Affairs to help complete an Asset Inventory and Assessment and has adequate funds to meet the necessary match requirements of the grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Hinsdale County, Colorado, the County Administrator be authorized to submit an application to the Department of Local Affairs on behalf of Hinsdale County requesting financial assistance to conduct an Asset Inventory and Assessment.
