BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS Meeting January 8, 2025

Commissioner Kristie Borchers called the regularly scheduled meeting to order at 10:01 a.m. on January 8, 2025. Those present were Commissioner Kristie Borchers, Commissioner Robert Hurd, Commissioner Greg Levine, Attorney Mike O'Loughlin, Administrator Sandy Hines, Finance Director Lynn McNitt, Road & Bridge Supervisor Don Menzies, EMS Director Katherine Heidt, Administrative Assistant Davee Menzies, Deputy Treasurer Lori Hanko, Assessor Sherri Boyce, Deputy Assessor Sarah Tubbs, Deputy Clerk Allison Athey, and general public.

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

There were no clarifications or deletions to the agenda.

Commissioner Levine motioned to approve the agenda. Commissioner Hurd seconded. Motion carried.

Commissioner Hurd motioned to approve the December 2024 minutes. Commissioner Levine seconded. Motion carried.

There were no citizen comments from the floor.

The 2 Alternant Slips: Slip A1 went to Tom Murphy; and Slip A2 went to Paul and Carole Clauss.

Commissioner Levine motioned to approve the documents for the purchase of 2 Ford Expeditions for the Sheriff's Department. Commissioner Hurd seconded. There are 5 documents to be signed out of meeting. Documents are the Master Equipment Lease-Purchase Agreement, the Amendment to the Master Equipment, Lease-Purchase Agreement, the Schedule to the Master Equipment Lease-Purchase Agreement, the Insurance Fact Sheet, and the IRS Form 8038-G. The Delivery and Acceptance Certificate will be signed at a later date. Motion carried.

Commissioner Hurd motioned to approve the Amended Employment Agreement for County Administrator Sandy Hines. Commissioner Levine seconded. This is with the 3% COLA increase; Sandy's annual salary is \$90,076.50. Motion carried.

Commissioner Levine motioned to approve the Amended Employment Agreement for Finance Director/Human Resources Lynn McNitt, Commissioner Hurd seconded. This is with the 3% COLA increase and includes All-Hazards Team pay. Lynn's annual salary is \$110,019.47. Motion carried.

Commissioner Levine motioned to approve the Amended Employment Agreement for Road and Bridge Supervisor and Shop Foreman Don Menzies. Commissioner Hurd seconded. This is with the 3% COLA increase; Don's annual salary is \$97,351.66. Motion carried.

Commissioner Hurd motioned to approve the Amended Employment Agreement for Building and Enforcement Officer Gabe McNesse. Commissioner Levine seconded. This is with the 3% COLA increase; Gabe's annual salary is \$55,102.97. Motion carried.

Commissioner Levine motioned to approve the Amended Employment Agreement for Emergency Manager Phil Graham. Commissioner Hurd seconded. This is with the 3% COLA increase and includes All-Hazards Team pay. Phil's annual salary is \$105,314.56. Motion carried

Commissioner Hurd motioned to approve the Amended Employment Agreement for EMS Director Katherine Heidt. Commissioner Levine seconded. This is with the 3% COLA increase; Katherine's annual salary is \$77,868.00. Motion carried.

Commissioner Levine motioned to adopt Resolution No. 1, Series 2025; a resolution setting rates for county mileage and meal reimbursement. Commissioner Hurd seconded. Reimbursement for mileage is \$0.56 per mile and for meals \$68.00 per day per diem. Motion carried.

Commissioner Hurd motioned to approve the Letter of Intent to apply for Gunnison County Stewardship Fund Grant.

Commissioner Levine seconded. Letter will be signed out of meeting. The due date is January 15, 2025. Motion carried.

Commissioner Levine motioned to approve the Special Events Permit for Lake City/Hinsdale County Chamber of Commerce's Brewski. Commissioner Hurd seconded. This is the 7th year for this event and it will be held on February 8, 2025 from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Insurance is in place and the application was reviewed per policy. Motion carried.

Commissioner Hurd motioned to pay all approved bills. Commissioner Levine seconded. The amount of bills approved is \$157,032.50. Motion carried.
